Speeding in Halstead

There have been a number of emails and letters over the past month related to speeding in the town. Most of them relate to the unsociable behaviour around Butler Road car park and the surrounding area. In addition to making unacceptable noise in the car park and dropping their rubbish, young drivers are using the area as a playground for dangerous driving and speeding and stunts. This has been reported to the police on a weekly basis recently, and we have been told by the police that they are beginning to take action on the behaviour in Butler Road.

Residents in neighbouring Beridge Road are requesting the installation of speed bumps in the road, and preferably also in Butler Road to protect the local children (this is very near to Holy Trinity School), and the elderly.

Recommendation: that the concerns raised by residents should be referred to the Local Highways Panel for their review of potential solutions to restrict speeding in Beridge Road and Butler Road.
