Re. TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER, TRAF/6637: 'NO WAITING 10AM-11AM', KINGS ROAD, HALSTEAD.

The proposed order, as indicated on the accompanying plan 'TL810 302 r5' (see red labels), was formally advertised 15th December 2017 to 8th January 2018, but due to objections from residents it was necessary to refer to a Cabinet Member for a decision on whether or not it should be implemented.

In July 2018, the report detailing the objections and other competing interests were evaluated by Councillor Bentley – Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Infrastructure. After careful consideration, he decided that waiting restrictions should be introduced as advertised.

At present, the volume of vehicles parking on the west side of this road, causes some vehicles, particularly larger goods vehicles, to drive on the footway when turning the corner from Trinity Street (A131) into Kings Road. No Waiting between 10am – 11am, will deter all day parking in sections of the road but still allow some parking for drivers. The order is approved with the intention of creating passing places for drivers to give way to oncoming vehicles from Trinity Street, and thus minimise the existing hazard/s.

We requested the developer to make the necessary arrangements to install the scheme as soon as possible but are still awaiting works dates. If you would like to know these dates, please, keep a check on <https://roadworks.org/> for up-to-date information.
